VENUE

Our venue, voco Gold Coast, is in a perfect location at Surfers Paradise on the Gold Coast, just one block from the beach, with views to the hinterland and really easy transport options. Gold Coast was chosen by membership this year as the regional city, outside of Brisbane, to host this year's event. TRANSPORT AND PARKING

Public transport options: Use the <u>Translink</u> website or mobile app to find details for travel to the venue. The Surfers Paradise G:link light rail station is right beside the hotel. Parking is available under the hotel for \$25 per day, or at the nearby <u>Bruce Bishop</u> <u>carpark</u> for \$16 per day (less for early arrival).

WHERE TO STAY

Whether you live locally, are flying into Gold Coast, or taking a road trip, this year's venue is centrally located and there are many accommodation options within Surfers Paradise, Broadbeach, Main Beach and Southport. FLIGHTS

You may like to fly into the Gold Coast Airport and catch public transport or an uber to the venue. Or fly into Brisbane Airport and catch the airport train from Brisbane to the Gold Coast. Jump onto the G:Link light rail service at Helensvale station and go straight to the hotel door. To track flight prices, go to <u>Skyscanner</u> or <u>google.com/travel/flights</u>, enter your departure City, dates and select 'track prices' to receive price alerts via email.
