



## **Men's Behaviour Change Program Practitioner**

The service facilitates a number of 16 week groups for men who perpetrate domestic and family violence, via a case management model. This position will be based on the Gold Coast.

#### **Practitioner Key Responsibilities:**

- Comprehensive risk assessment, case management, co-facilitation of men's behaviour change and/or maintenance groups; referrals for additional services including housing and family support, client advocacy, and practical support to ensure safety and well-being of our clients in all their diversity.
- A minimum of 2 years' experience in the domestic violence sector with knowledge of the Domestic Violence Legislation, Practice Standards and crisis intervention is essential.
- Gendered analysis of Domestic and Family Violence.

This position requires relevant tertiary qualifications in Social Work, Psychology, Social or Behavioral Sciences from a recognised tertiary institution or equivalent. Eligibility for membership of PACFA, APS, AASW, or similar recognised professional association is also required.

A current driver's licence, current (or eligibility for) Qld Working with Children Check – 'Blue Card', Federal Police Check and evidence of Australian Work Rights to confirm citizenship or a visa holder is required.

Centacare and CFRS offer opportunities for career advancement and a supportive environment to attract appropriate and long term practitioners.
