VENUE

Hotel Grand Chancellor is located in Spring Hill Brisbane, directly across from the beautiful Roma Street Parklands, central to easy transport options and a 15 minute walk to Brisbane's CBD shopping and dining precinct. Delegates are provided a discount code for their stay at the hotel which has family rooms, if you choose to stay the weekend.

TRANSPORT AND PARKING

Public transport options: Use the [Translink](#) website or mobile app to find details for travel to the venue. Central and Roma St train stations and numerous bus routes are close to the hotel. There is Parking is available under the hotel for \$20 per day for delegates, at [Get Parked](#) next to the hotel for \$13 per day, and [Secure Parking](#) a 2 minute from the hotel for as little as \$16 per day depending on entry time and pre-booking.

WHERE TO STAY

Travelling locally, flying into Brisbane, or driving in, this year's venue is centrally located. There are alternative accommodation options within Spring Hill and Brisbane CBD.
